At The University of Akron, Mr. and Mrs. Lloyd served as co-chairs for the University's \$500 million *Aspire. Attain. Advance.* resource development campaign. Undaunted by the campaign goal, the Lloyd's and their co-chairs, Gary and Karen Taylor, raised a milestone \$606.5 million for faculty positions, student scholarships, and campus facilities. Under Mr. Lloyd's leadership, The University of Akron Foundation has concluded three consecutive years of raising more than \$40 million per year. As chair of the Foundation's Women in Philanthropy committee, Mrs. Lloyd launched the Elizabeth Buchtel Award, which recognizes giving by women to the University.

At the Akron Art Museum, Mr. Lloyd has twice served as chair of the Museum and co-chaired the Museum's Create a Master Piece Capital Campaign, which raised an unprecedented \$41 million for the physical expansion of the facility. Mrs. Lloyd has also chaired numerous fundraising events for the Akron Art Museum, notably the Faux Ball.

At Akron General Health System, Mr. Lloyd heads the Medical Center and Health System's Board of Trustees. During his tenure, Akron General has raised more than \$25 million. Currently the Women's Board chair, Mrs. Lloyd has led the Board's Annual Gala.
